The Blue Envelope is a vital component of the S.A.V.E.S. Project, aimed at improving traffic stop interactions for individuals with special needs and first responders. It involves preparing a personalized envelope containing relevant documents and information to facilitate understanding and safety during traffic encounters.

Recognition of the S.A.V.E.S Project Logo

The S.A.V.E.S Project Logo was designed specifically to be recognizable. Participants are instructed to place the S.A.V.E.S Project decal on the back window in the lower left corner of their vehicle. This window decal is an identifier to first responders there may be a S.A.V.E.S Project participant inside of the vehicle.

Traffic Stop Tips

- Stay calm
 - Deep breathing helps manage stress
- Use your Blue Envelope
 - Keep in an easily accessible place
- Follow instructions
 - Ask questions if you do not understand
- Waiting
 - A traffic stop can take up to 15 minutes
- Safety first
 - Keep your hands visible at all times and remain in your vehicle

Envelope Preparation

- Gather you documents
 - driver's license, registration, insurance, completed "About Me" form
- Place documents inside
 - secure all documents inside your envelope
- Place in sun visor
 - This allows your envelope to be easily accessible
- Inform family and update regularly
 - Update your documents every six months and your "About Me" form
